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BILLERICA HOUSING AUTHORITY PARKING POLICY

As parking on BHA properties is limited, this Billerica Housing Authority Parking Policy is adopted and shall supercede and replace any existing rules, regulations, or parking policies previously established by the BHA.

Resident Overnight Parking between the hours of Midnight and 8:00 AM will be permitted in BHA Parking areas only with the use of a BHA parking sticker. There are no assigned parking spaces in BHA Parking Lots. Parking is on a first-come-first-served basis. Resident Parking Applications may be obtained and completed at the BHA Office. The resident must provide his/her vehicle registration. A maximum of one (1) sticker shall be allowed per each resident apartment (household). Only vehicles with active, updated registration and inspection stickers are permitted. There shall be no fees for a BHA parking sticker. Overnight guests, or those requiring long term overnight parking, must contact the Office.

The BHA sticker must be placed on the inside of the upper left corner of the rear window. Placement of the sticker anywhere else on the vehicle will render the sticker invalid and subject the vehicle to ticketing and/or towing. In the event the BHA sticker is lost, damaged, or requires replacement due to vehicle change, a new replacement sticker (maximum of one replacement sticker per year) will be issued at no charge. The old sticker will be invalidated in the BHA Parking system thus rendering the old sticker invalid. Any vehicle displaying an old invalid sticker may be subject to ticketing and/or towing.

Abandoned or unregistered vehicles are not permitted.

Use of BHA parking areas is entirely at the risk of the vehicle owner/operator. The BHA is not responsible for damage to vehicles or property. Making repairs to vehicles is not allowed on BHA property. Vehicles must be operated safely and responsibly at all times and not cause damage to BHA property or cause unnecessary disturbances such as noise, smoke or exhaust fumes.
